Policies

Weather Cancellation/Delays

There is one in-person weather make-up lesson per-student per-semester. Students are responsible for consulting their teacher for weather-related cancellations, as music classes do not always follow the Darien Public School closings.

Illness Policy

1. Stay Home if Sick

- If your child has a fever, cough, sore throat, vomiting, diarrhea, or any contagious illness, please keep them home.
- Students should be symptom-free for at least 24 hours without medication before returning.
- Students displaying symptomatic conditions may be sent home.

2. Notify Us

- Let us know as soon as possible if your child will miss class due to illness by notifying the instructor and the office.

Pro-Rating

Cancellation & Make-Up Policy

Student Cancellation: There are no make-ups for student cancellations.

Teacher Cancellation: In the event the teacher cannot make the lesson, they or the DAC will inform the student. Students are entitled to a make up lesson that will be scheduled between the student and the faculty member.

Liability Waiver

I understand that art, dance, martial arts and music lessons and group classes involve activities and interactions that may be new to my child and that these come with certain risks and uncertainties beyond what my child may have previously been exposed to. I am aware of these risks, and I am assuming them on behalf of my child. I realize that no environment is risk-free, and I have instructed my child on the importance of abiding by DAC’s rules. My child and I both agree that he or she is familiar with these rules and will obey them. DAC reserves the right to remove or reassign any student from its classes.

Participation in DAC activities involves certain inherent risks. DAC will not be held liable for any injuries sustained by participants or their children during DAC activities. By taking part in DAC programs, participants waive any right or cause of action arising from participation that could result in liability claims against DAC or its officers, directors, agents, employees, volunteers, and/or donors, whether collectively or individually, except in cases of gross negligence.
